

## TEST CHANGES IN HAC

### The following test updates have been made in HAC:

A "Magic i" has been added to the test listing for LD Isoenzymes (4339/LDI) to notify clients that specimens for this test must be collected in a plain red top tube, spun, separated and transferred to a Mayo aliquot tube prior to transport to AML.

## UPCOMING HAC CYTOLOGY ORDER ENTRY CHANGES
